



**ISB's 4th Annual French and Spanish Children's Book Fair
to take place at John Jay High School (Park Slope) on Saturday, Dec. 6**

November 24, 2008, Brooklyn, NY – International School of Brooklyn (ISB) adds another chapter to its annual French and Spanish Children's Book Fair, one of New York City's largest multilingual book events for children ages 0 to 10. Since its inception in 2005, ISB's Book Fair has doubled and this year will be the biggest event yet with over 1,500 beautifully-illustrated books, educational magazines, CDs, DVDs and games in French, Spanish and English.

"We are proud that this event has grown to be a mainstay resource for in-language educational material for New York families raising their children in a multilingual environment," said Rebecca Skinner, co-founder and executive director of ISB.
