After the class, the children can bring home their decorated masterpiece as well as a special surprise.

“Children have a natural knack for creation and these workshops are structured to let them get creative with the elements of cake-decorating in a professional setting,” said Mr. Poussot, who has taught baking workshops at Le Cordon Bleu and other culinary institutes. “It will be a fun afternoon for both children and adults.”

The workshops are a special fundraiser to benefit International School of Brooklyn (ISB), a new non-profit French and Spanish language immersion school in Park Slope.
