ISB Doubles in Size in its Second Year and Begins the New Application Season with Series of Open Houses

***First Grade Class to be Added for 2007-2008 School Year;
Application Deadline for Nursery to First Grade Slots is December 22, 2006***

Brooklyn, NY – October 3, 2006 – International School of Brooklyn (ISB), the borough's only French/Spanish language-immersion school, successfully started its second year with a new Kindergarten Grade and doubled in size to 33 enrolled students.

The school continues to follow the International Baccalaureate (IB) Primary Years Programme, catered to preschool- and elementary-age children. The IB program provides an educational framework for developing the whole child – socially, physically, emotionally and culturally.

ISB currently offers Nursery, Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten. First Grade will be added in September 2007, and additional grades each subsequent year.

To kick off the new application season, ISB will host a series of Open Houses on:
