



ISB Completes its Move to Prospect Heights and Grows in Numbers

Schedule of Open Houses Announced; Application Deadline is Dec. 14

Brooklyn, NY – October 4, 2007 – International School of Brooklyn (ISB), New York's only French/Spanish language-immersion school following the International Baccalaureate (IB) curriculum, successfully opened its doors at its new location in dynamic Prospect Heights to 62 students in grades Nursery through First Grade.

The school has nearly doubled, up from 33 students in grades Nursery through Kindergarten last year. Next September, the school expects to grow to 80 students in Nursery through Second Grade.

In addition to 16 faculty and staff, ISB has added new directors to oversee its expanding programs. Muriel Stallworth joins the school as Educational Director. Ms. Stallworth brings extensive IB teaching experience having been a former teacher at Washington International School (WIS) in Washington, D.C. Jennifer Henriquez, Community Development Director, will oversee community-wide enrichment programs including playgroups, afterschool and summer camp classes, all of which are open to students outside of ISB. Rebecca Skinner, Executive Director and Co-Founder, continues to become involved in day-to-day operations.

Charles Ruoff, Associate Broker at Brown Harris Stevens and a big supporter of ISB, also joins the school as a new member of its Board of Directors. Mr. Ruoff is a member of the Prospect Park Alliance and active community member.
